### **GLANCE AT TWU**

Trinity Western University (TWU) was established in 1962, being the Canada's premier private Christian university and the second oldest university in BC province. Having developed for nearly half century, TWU currently owns over 7,000 students, and 85% school faculties are PhD. It is a full member of the Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada (AUCC) and The Royal Society of Canada (RSC). The University is also recognized by the U.S. Department of Education as well as the Ministry of Education of the People's Republic of China, for it continually earns A+ for seven years for its overall quality of education reported in The Globe and Mail.

Trinity Western University has five campuses in total in Canada, separately located in the capital Ottawa, breathtaking Salt Spring Island and Metro Vancouver. Metro Vancouver's three campuses are mostly welcomed by the international students. For example, Langley campus as the main campus of TWU, covers an area of 157 acres in Fort Langley, where the student can be exposed to both historical culture and natural scenery. The other two campuses are in Richmond, which is famous for the highly urbanization, providing the students with the convenience regarding their learning, career and life.

Trinity Western University warmly embraces all the students no matter whether they have faith or not, even though the University itself has the historical backgrounds of Christianity. Besides the high-quality teaching displayed, TWU aims to equip the students to find and fulfil their purposes in life. Students in TWU will receive a whole-person education, learning practical professional skills and exploring bigger ideas about who they are and what they are meant to do. Meanwhile, they could also get involved in a warm and welcoming community, and pursue how their gifts and abilities could make an eternal impact on the world.

Trinity Western University offer up to 48 undergraduate and 17 graduate degree programs, involving in the seven fields of study like Humanity, Science, Business, Arts and Design, Education, Human Kinetics and Nursing, of which the most popular international programs are as following. International students' tuition fees are the same with that of the local students'.

- U1 (University First Year): targets to the high school students; after the U1 study, the students could either transfer to other universities in North America, or continue studying at TWU with 48 bachelor's degree programs to choose.
- GXP (Global Express Pathway): U1U2 online courses that could be learned at any time in any place, thus the student could save both the cost and time; when backing to face-toface classes, the students could either transfer to other universities in North America, or continue studying at TWU with most of the bachelor's degree programs to choose.



- Bachelor of Arts in Leadership: accept up to 60 block-transfer credits; the students spend as few as 16 months at TWU to complete their undergraduate study, and are eligible for applying for the 3-year post-graduate work permit.
- Bachelor of Arts in Leadership Professionals: all courses are accelerated and arranged in the evening; accept up to 60 block-transfer credits; students are eligible for applying for the 3-year post-graduate work permit.
- Master of Arts in Leadership (Business Stream): neither GRE/GMAT nor academic/working backgrounds needed; affordable tuition; graduation within 18 months in average and the post-graduate work permit is applicable.
- Master of Business Administration: students could be enrolled in every month; the bridge courses are offered for those whose GPA could not meet the direct entry requirement; neither GRE/GMAT nor academic/working backgrounds needed; graduation within 17 months in average and the post-graduate work permit is applicable.

### **KNOW ABOUT TLC**

Trinity Language Centre (TLC) offers university language pathway programs for students. At TLC, language courses are conducted by combining content-area materials and academic English skills in a caring and supporting environment. TLC offers free Supervised Assignment Sessions and one-on-one bilingually tutoring to help in-class and after-class teaching and learning. Various learning assistance is offered to cater to the learning needs of individual students.

The applicants who could not meet the language entrance requirements will be placed in the proper program in TLC: Academic English Study (AES) for undergraduate preparation as well as Pre-Graduate Study (PGS) for graduate preparation. There are four levels for AES programs, and each of them lasts for 15 weeks (with 25 hours of weekly teaching and support). For AES programs, TLC specifically sets up 9 starting days for flexible enrolment every year. As to the PGS programs, TLC accepts new student for three times among year-round, which are in January, May, and September. For those who do not have valid IELTS/TOEFL scores, TLC assigned the students to participate in the Canadian Academic English Language Assessment (CAEL) or TLC in-house test, of which the grades will be taken account into the program level placement (the test date: https://www.twu-tlc.ca/application/important-dates/).

TLC currently has two campuses, located in TWU Langley Campus and TWU Richmond Minoru Campus. The former one displays the local culture and history, contributing the international students to blending into the western environment; whereas, the latter one is within walking distance to the sky-train stations, public library and shopping centers, facilitating the students to experience a convenient and colourful foreign life!

### **AGENT COMMITMENT**

This Welcome Package also provide detailed description for being a qualified Can-Future' Agent. A good understanding about the Agent's responsibilities and limitations will contribute to a positively mutual relationship between agent and Can-Future. Failure to follow the guidelines or impart the fraudulent information to the students or the institutions we serve may result in the termination of our Agency Agreement.

As an authorized representative in international student recruitment, your Agent agrees:

- To represent Can-Future/TWU/TLC to obtain applications for admission to TWU and TLC.
- To represent TWU and TLC in all ways that would present a positive image and maintain the professional reputation of TWU and TLC.
- To honestly and accurately provide TWU's and TLC's program entrance requirements, tuition fees and refund policies with students.
- To endeavor to introduce and recommend applicants who are academically and financially qualified for admission to TWU and TLC.
- To submit completed documentation of the student's application to Can-Future promptly by email or any other efficient method as required.
- To provide thorough training for all new counselors to ensure that they are equipped to properly direct students.
- Not to act or on purpose to act in the name or on behalf of TWU or TLC in any matter beyond the scope of this Agreement unless expressly authorized and directed by Can-Future.



### **COMMISSION DISTRIBUTION**

The following information provides your agent with the detailed Can-Future commission rate, payment method and conditions.

- Can-Future shall pay the Agent commission as 15% of the first two semesters' tuition fee
  paid by each student only for the fulltime undergraduate programs, such as U1, BA
  Leadership offered by TWU. The third semester commission of C\$1,500 flat fee will be
  paid by each qualified student for U1, UG, BA leadership programs.
- For the GXP (Global Express Pathway/ U1U2 online) program, Can-Future shall pay the Agent commissions for the following two parts:
  - 1) Can-Future distribute 20% of the tuition fee paid by each full-time student for the GXPprogram in every semester;
  - 2) After the student finishes GXP and back to face-to-face courses, Can-Future distribute 15% of the next two semesters' tuition fee paid by each full-time student.
- Can-Future shall pay the Agent commission \$1,500 for each of the first two semesters onlyfor the fulltime master degree programs, such as MA Leadership, MBA, Dual Master Degree of MA Leadership and MS Information Technology offered in TWU.
- Can-Future shall pay the Agent commission \$1,000 in each semester only for the fulltime program offered by TLC.
- CAN-FUTURE shall pay the commission of C\$1200 for each of the first two semesters for each qualified student studying in MA in Interdisciplinary Humanities.
- For VPC TWU BA Leadership Pathway
- 1) For VPC diploma programs (Hospitality Management/ Business Management/ General Studies), CAN-FUTURE shall pay 20% commission (GST included) of the tuition fee for the entire program of study.
- 2) For TWU BA Leadership program, CAN-FUTURE shall pay 15% commission of the first two semesters' tuition fee (C\$622/credit) and C\$1,500 flat fee for the third semester (GST included) for each qualified student.
- For VPC TWU MA Leadership Pathway
- 1) For VPC post-graduate programs (Digital Marketing/ Hospitality Management), CAN-FUTURE shall pay 20% commission (GST included) of the tuition fee for the entire program of study.
- 2) For TWU MA Leadership program, CAN-FUTURE shall pay the commission of C\$1,200 (GST included) for each of the first two semesters only for each qualified student.

### Can**∲** Future

- Delivery of commission of each semester will be made within eight weeks after the end
  of the add/drop period when students enroll at TWU or TLC and tuition is fully paid.
  The commission is payable only when the Agent has submitted the *Commission Request*Form accordingly.
- If a student enrolls less than a minimum of 12 semester hours at TWU in in any semester of study, the commission payment will be deferred until the next subsequent semester in which the student enrolls more than 12 semester hours.

- Agent will get an Agent Training through the ways either on-line or in-person, when the key programs' information will be explained, and the relevant flyers, videos and other useful materials will be sent.
- Agent will be arranged to sign the Agent Agreement, and provide the effective documents (individual agent is asked to send the copy of <u>ID card</u> whereas company agency should offer your latest <u>Business License</u>,
- Agent will be awarded the Agent Authorization Certificate by CAN-FUTURE Education Consulting Pvt Ltd, and will be granted the authority to recruit the international students for Trinity Western University (TWU) and Trinity Language Center (TLC).
