### **Admission Requirements**

### A. Direct Entry

- Completion of a diploma or post-secondary courses in progress (for at least two-year study)
- A minimum GPA of 2.7 Applicar
  - Applicant age: over 23 years old
- Minimum one-year work experience
- A minimum overall IELTS 6.0 with no band lower than 5.5, or a minimum overall TOEFL 78 with each section more than 20

### **B. TLC + TWU Conditional Admission**

- Completion of a diploma or post-secondary courses in process (for at least two-year study)
- A minimum GPA of 2.7
- Applicant age: over 23 years old
- Minimum one-year work experience
- Not meet the BA in Leadership Professionals direct-entry language requirements The students could also be admitted after successfully completing the Academic English Study (AES). AES is provided by Trinity Language Centre (TLC) located in both TWU Richmond and Langley campus, and contains four levels. Each level lasts for 15 weeks.

- Completed and signed application form
- Application fee of \$150 CAD (non-refundable)
- All official post-secondary transcripts (Transcripts outside both the North America and China are required to pay \$140 CAD for credential evaluation)
- All recognized post-secondary diplomas or degrees (School Enrollment Letter is required if the student has not graduated yet)
- Official Proof of English Language Proficiency (IELTS or TOEFL report, if applicable)
- One Reference Letter from the employer (To demonstrate the work experience and ability)
- Passport
- Status in Canada: study permit, permanent resident card (if applicable)
