

### **Global Express Pathway (GXP)**

- Length of GXP: 4 semesters, as short as 16 months
- Total credits: 61
- Enrollment dates: January, May, September
- Each semester: 5 courses
- Each course: online self-learning tutorials + 2 hrs/week online facilitation
- Studying location: anywhere
- Tuition: totally C\$22,631 = C\$371/credit \* 61 credits
- \* C\$35 activity fee not included
- \* including one free individual online tutoring for one hour per month.

# Comparison

### "GXP+UG" VS. "Traditional UG programs"

#### More flexible:

The first 2-yr GXP courses can be taken at any time in any place

#### More affordable:

The first 2-yr GXP courses save around 50% in tuition (C\$22,000)

#### More practical:

GXP courses are accepted by most TWU UG programs and can also be transferred to other Canadian universities

Examples of the course format arrangements for some programs:

- BA programs :
  - GXP (4 semesters) + F2F (4 semesters)
- BBA/Edu :
  - GXP (4 semesters) + F2F (5 semesters)
- CS/Bio/Biotech :
  - GXP (3 semesters) + F2F (5 semesters)
- Bio (Hons.)/Biotech (Hons):

  GXP (3 semesters) + E2F (6 semesters)

## **Admission Requirements**

#### > CANADIAN STUDENT - BC Curriculum

- High school graduation diploma with a 70% average;
- Must include English 12 plus three additional Grade 12 academic subjects; and
- English 12 requirement is over 55%.

#### > INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

- High school graduation diploma with a 70% average;
- A minimum overall IELTS 6.0 (with each band ≥ 5.5);
  - or a minimum overall TOEFL 78 (with each secstion ≥ 19),
- **or** three years of full-time study and graduation from an international English-medium school.
- Trinity Language Centre (TLC) provides the language pathway program for those whose language proficiency could not meet the GXP direct entry requirements.

(\*Students could also be admitted after successfully completing the Academic English Study (AES) program. AES is provided by Trinity Language Centre (TLC) located in both TWU Richmond campus and Langley campus, and contains four levels. Each level lasts for 15 weeks. TLC specifically sets up 9 starting dates per year for flexible enrolment.)

## **GXP+UG Application Document Checklist**

- Completed and Signed Application Form
- Application fee of \$150 CAD (non-refundable)
- Copies of high school and post-secondary transcripts (original and English versions)
- Copies of original and notarized high school diploma (Enrollment Letter is needed if not graduated yet)
- Proof of English Language Proficiency (IELTS, TOFEL...)
- A copy of the student's passport info page
- Proof of status in Canada like study permit, PR card... (if applicable)
