

MA Leadership / Pre-graduate Studies (PGS):

January, May, September

Location of study: TWU Richmond and Langley campus

Tuition Fees: CAD \$27,030 for 34 credits

Duration of program: 18 months **Admission Requirements**

A. Direct Entry

- Undergraduate completion with a minimum GPA of 2.75
- A minimum overall IELTS 7.0 with no band lower than 7.0, or a minimum overall TOEFL 100 with each section more than 25

Supporting documents:

- Resume Personal statement Two reference letters
- Transcripts from all post-secondary institutions (all international applicants outside the North America are required to pay \$140 CAD for a credential evaluation)
- Recognized graduation certificate and bachelor's degree (enrollment letter is required if the student has not graduated yet)
- IELTS or TOEFL report (if applicable)











B. PGS Conditional Admission

- Undergraduate completion with a minimum GPA of 2.75
- The students who are not able to meet MA Leadership direct-entry language requirements could also be admitted after successfully completing the Pre-Graduate Studies (PGS). PGS is provided by Trinity Language Center (TLC), located in both TWU Richmond and Langley campus, and contains two levels of PGS1 and PGS2. Both levels combine language classes and undergraduate courses during 15-week of learning.
