Admission Requirements

A. Direct Entry

- Undergraduate completion with a minimum GPA of 3.0 (GPA of 2.75-3.0 could be admitted with conditional offer)
- A minimum overall IELTS 7.0 with no band lower than 7.0, or a minimum overall TOEFL 100 with each section more than 25

B. PGS Conditional Admission

- Undergraduate completion with a minimum GPA of 3.0
- Not meet the MBA direct-entry language requirements

The students could also be admitted after successfully completing the Pre-Graduate Studies (PGS). PGS is provided by Trinity Language Center (TLC) located in both TWU Richmond and Langley campus, and contains two levels of PGS1 and PGS2. Each level lasts for 15 weeks, combined by language classes and undergraduate courses.

C. MBA Bridge Courses Conditional Admission

- Undergraduate completion with a minimum GPA of 2.3
- Meet the MBA direct-entry language requirements

The students could also be admitted after successfully completing the Bridge courses. Bridge courses are provided by TWU Richmond Campus and consist of 5 undergraduate courses (15 credits). Students should achieve a minimum GPA 3.0 to enter MBA program.

D. PGS and Bridge Courses Conditional Admission

- Undergraduate completion with a minimum GPA of 2.3
- Not meet the MBA direct-entry language requirements







The students will be admitted to TLC to improve English proficiency first. After successfully completing PGS2, they are eligible to continue learning Bridge Courses of 5 BA Leadership courses (15 credits). If the students could achieve a minimum GPA of 3.0 when finishing the Bridge courses, they will enter MBA program.
